After completing the logon process you will have access to the dynamic FleetSeek database purchased.

FleetSeek allows you to access to each change made to listed records plus any new fleets added.

Changes and additions found by our research staff are posted every three days, making this one of the most up to date reference products on the market today.

The five industry segments offered are;


1. The National Motor Carrier Directory (USA)

How to use the FleetSeek Query.

FleetSeek offers subscribers the opportunity to query among numerous fields to isolate individual fleets or groups of fleets which meet that user's immediate needs. If no query is used, all records will be selected for the active database(s). Using data elements on the query screen allows the user to further define their specific demographic profile.

The first query for purchasers of more than one FleetSeek database is to select the database(s) to be queried by ensuring (or placing) a check mark exists in the box preceding the desired database(s) name.

If you wish to see everything FleetSeek has to offer in the selected database(s), you're done. Simply press the **SEARCH** the database button.

To refine your selection further, you may select on any of the query items listed. A user only need provide information necessary to properly define the desired companies. You do not need to enter something into each field. In fact, less is better. (If you over-define your selection, you may inadvertently eliminate the very fleet(s) you're trying to see.)

1. For single record searches

Enter Company name (is not case sensitive; can enter without spaces, &. -, /, or other superfluous variables).

To select by USDOT or Motor Carrier Number fill in one or the other with an appropriate number.

2. Select Country State(s) or Province(s)

3. Select USA County by State(s)

In the following sections there are **range boxes** and **pick lists** that help define and limit the carriers you view, print or download. By design, all carriers will be included in a selection unless you take a specific action. Note that you do not need to take an action in each and every possible choice, but only for those which produce the carriers of interest to you.

For example, if you're looking for large refrigerated fleets, just key in From 100 To 99999 tractors (99999 defines the upper limit), and select Refrigerated from the Trailer Type select box. You can leave all other selection criteria alone because selecting them at this time will only serve to further limit (decrease) the carriers meeting your initial criteria.
